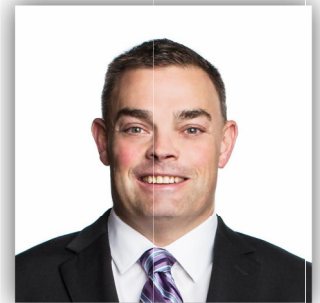


### NEW PHYSICIAN JOINS MIDWEST GI
