## POST ENTYVIO INFUSION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Return to your diet and medications and normal activities.
- 2. Serious allergic reactions are rare, however if you experience any of the following, please call our office.
  - Hives
  - Itching
  - Trouble Breathing
  - Chest Pain
  - Dizziness
  - Wheezing
  - Chills
  - Rash
  - Nausea
  - Flushing of skin
  - Low blood pressure

IF ANY OF THESE SYMPTOMS OCCUR, PLEASE CALL YOUR DOCTOR AT 402-397-7057 DURING REGULAR BUSINESS HOURS OR GO TO THE EMERGENCY ROOM FOR EVALUATION.

- 3. IV Site: If site is tender, apply a warm, wet washcloth applied for 15 to 20 minutes, four times a day can help ease discomfort.
- 4. Inform your PCP that you are not to receive live vaccines including the shingles vaccine and flu mist.
- 5. Always eat and drink plenty of fluids before you infusion.
- 6. Schedule elective dental/surgical procedures 4 weeks after infusion.
- 7. If taking antibiotic or if you have a fever or feel ill and it is time for your infusion, please call your case manager as you may need to reschedule.
