POST TYSABRI (NATALIZUMAB) INFUSION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Return to your diet and medications and normal activities.
- 2. Serious allergic reactions usually happen within 2 hours of the start of the infusion, but can happen at any time after receiving Tysabri. If you experience any of the following, please call our office.
 - Hives
 - Itching
 - Trouble breathing
 - Cheat pain
 - Dizziness
 - Wheezing

- Chills
- Rash
- Nausea
- Flushing of skin
- Low blood pressure

IF ANY OF THESE SYMPTOMS OCCUR, PLEASE CALL YOUR DOCTOR AT 402-397-7057 DURING REGULAR BUSINESS HOURS OR GO TO THE EMERGENCY ROOM FOR EVALUATION.

- 3. Other side effects may include:
 - Headache
 - Urinary tract infection
 - joint pain
 - Increased fatigue

- Upper respiratory infection
- Vaginitis
- Depression
- Pain in arms, legs or stomach
- 4. IV Site: If site is tender, apply a warm wet washcloth for 15-20 minutes four times a day to ease the discomfort.
- 5. Inform your PCP that you are not to receive live vaccines including the shingles vaccine and flu mist.
- 6. Always eat and drink plenty of fluids before you infusion.
- 7. Schedule elective dental/surgical procedures 4 weeks after infusion.
- 8. If taking antibiotic or if you have a fever or feel ill and it is time for your next dose of Stelara, please call your case manager as you may need to reschedule.
